You are hiring an aluminium boat with an 8HP motor that travels at less than 10 knots.

You are not required to have a boat licence to operate this vessel; however, you must comply with the following:

1.

- a) All passengers and the driver must remain entirely within the vessel while underway.
- b) The vessel is not to be taken outside the areas indicated on the provided map.
- c) While underway you will take care to avoid other craft and will give way to sailing vessels.
- d) Navigation instructions are attached to your boat. Please follow these directives.
- e) Do not attempt to 'raft up' or tie-up next to other craft.
- f) Children under 12 MUST wear a lift jacket at all times.
- g) Any person in the boat ALONE (regardless of age) MUST wear a lift jacket.
- h) No smoking on vessels at any time.
- Alcohol and drugs are forbidden for use by the person hiring/operating the vessel.
- 2. The motor is operated by pulling on the start cable with the engine **in neutral**.

Forward and reverse gears power the vessel when underway.

The motor will not start when in gear. To stop the motor, push the round button on the engine face. In the event of emergency, the motor can be stopped by pulling the safety lanyard from the motor (as shown by staff). Unleaded fuel is supplied with the vessel and there is more than enough fuel for one days motoring. If for some reason the fuel does not appear to be getting to the motor, check the fuel lines to see if they are properly connected.

Fuel may need to be pumped through the line using the hand valve on the fuel line.

The motor is the only mechanical device on the boat that requires your attention.

Oars/paddles are supplied for manual operation and an anchor is stored in the bow of the vessel.

There are life jackets provided for all on board. They are stored in the bow of the boat. In the event they are needed, pass the jacket over your head and fasten by clicking the tab on the front of the jacket. Pull to make firm around your waist.

Remember children under 12 must always wear a life jacket while aboard the vessel. Any person, regardless of age, must wear a life jack if on the boat alone. NO EXCEPTIONS.

A torch is supplied, and a bailing bucket is in the boat.

3. You have been provided with a map of the safe operating area. Do not take the boat outside the areas marked. The contact number for Yamba Marina is clearly marked on the map. (6646 9898)
